



Hammer Tip Kit

For use with: Any Rhodes™ Piano originally equipped with rubber (Neoprene) hammer tips.

Your piano may have been altered since it was built, but the original arrangement of hammer tips is shown below

**NOTE:** The numbers shown here are KEY numbers, based on the left most or lowest key being #1 - they ARE NOT based on the numbers stamped in the tone bars.

73 note: 1-22 Red, 23-32 Green, 33-42 Yellow, 43-56 White, 57-73 Wood  
 88 note: 1-30 Red, 31-40 Green, 41-50 Yellow, 51-64 White, 64-88 Wood

OLD TIP REMOVAL

Care must be taken not to twist the hammer as you remove the old tips. Supporting the hammer with one hand, peel off the old tip with the other hand. Then use a sharp tool to scrape off any left over rubber, glue, and/or debris from the end of the hammer. Take your time, and repeat for all the hammers of the piano.

NEW TIP INSTALLATION

**NOTE:** Keep track of your location - our kits always have a few extra tips in each bag, so be sure you change from one tip hardness to the next according to the key numbers and NOT when the preceding bag is empty. Retain any extra tips for future repairs.

**WARNING:** Be sure to read and observe all cautions and warnings on glue packaging before proceeding

DO ONE HAMMER AT A TIME. Place a drop of CA Glue (Provided) on the end of the hammer and place the correct hammer tip in place. Hold for 30 seconds being sure the tip is positioned correctly before proceeding to the next hammer.

**Once all the new tips are installed allow the glue to cure for at least 24 hours before playing the instrument!**
